QUALIFICATIONS

- A. **Education:** Certification and registration with ARRT. Pursuing or licensed with the State of TN
- B. Graduate from an approved radiological technology education program.
- C. **Experience**: Angiography technologist work with adult patients and must performs all phases of angiographic procedures including patient monitoring and intervention, scrubbing, circulating, positioning, PACS, and data entry.
- D. Skill in performing imaging examinations, ability to understand and prepare complex written materials, such as medical records, ability to work without close supervision, ability to organize multiple tasks and projects and maintain control of work flow.

JOB FUNCTIONS

- Performs imaging examinations as established by physician procedure guidelines
- Provide ongoing patient assessment through observation of patients and records; reports findings accurately and timely
- Ensures that equipment performance is optimum, performs appropriate quality control test and adjustments to maximize image quality
- Obtains CE and certification
- Ensures that patient care or department related communications are coordinated among all clinic members.
- Attends departmental meetings
- Maintains supply inventory
- Demonstrates knowledge and competent operation of RIS and PACS system.
